- 4) there must be 2 score keepers per group and the score keepers must keep a running score
- 5) there must be a minimum of 4 people per group and of the 4 people, 1 person must be 18 years of age or over
- 6) score cards must be totaled and signed by the score keepers

7) all shooters must be done by 4:00 p.m.

Registration: should flow smoother. Staggered start was again discussed but because of the traffic pattern of the course, it would not be a possibility.

Staff shirts and club shirts: was discussed and Brenda will inventory what is on hand and we will decide what to do at a later meeting. We will try some other printers because of the "problems" that we have had
