## What's New!

The Nevada Bowhunters Association had its midwinter meeting on December 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Perdiz Shooting Sports Clubhouse just outside of Eureka, Nevada. A synopsis of the minutes will probably be included in the next NBHA Newsletter.

A few of the items that might be of immediate interest to you are: 1) the dates that have been set for some of the shoots (included on a separate page), 2) the NBHA State Outdoor Tournament will be held a multiple locations in an effort to make them more accessible and affordable to participants. Any club can submit a bid to host the event and the tournaments must be held within the fiscal year that ends with the Jamboree in Eureka. Participants may compete in more than one State Outdoor or State Marked 3D tournament however; each participant must declare that a tournament is his All-around entry before starting the tournament (should a person be competing for the All-around title). There will be an additional \$5.00 entry fee at each tournament (indoor, outdoor, marked 3D = total of \$15.00) to qualify for the All-around silver buckle. Take a look at Larry's buckle, it is Pres. Worth more than prreeettttyyyyy. **\$15.00.** (An old guy I know said he really didn't like the buckle because the points on the top edge would poke into his waist (belly) and he couldn't see the buckle anyway. Have you ever heard of such an excuse?) 3) It was decided that the president of NBHA needed access to funds without authorization from the Board; approved not to exceed \$500 for the year. 4) There was also a proposal to put money spots on the Jamboree targets to raise participation and interest. Also FYI, the NBHA is asking each club to donate a raffle item which was commonly done for many **IMPORTANT**, The Fallon Bowmen will be in charge of setting up 10 targets for the Jamboree. If you are planning to attend, don't be shy. We would appreciate any help you can give! I will remind everyone as the time gets closer.
